# **Drug Free Workplace Program/Policy**

Implementing a drug-free workplace program is one of the most pro-active measures employers can take to reduce substance abuse issues within their organization. A comprehensive drug screening program will consist of the following:

Pre-hire drug screening

- 2 Post-incident drug screening
- 3 Random drug screenings
- 4 Reasonable suspicion drug screenings
