# Crushing Foot Injury: Case Study

An employee working in a high hazard operation sustained a devastating crushing injury to his left foot, resulting in extensive soft tissue loss. The injury required multiple surgical interventions over several months and placed the employee at significant risk for amputation.

From the outset, this claim carried substantial medical, functional, and financial exposure. Preserving the foot depended on sustained engagement, medical adherence, and precise coordination across the recovery timeline.

## Beyond the Injury: Hidden Risks to Recovery
