"Everything is good... 'til it ain't!"

Nobody comes to work with the mindset, "I'd like to do something to get injured today," but injuries continue to occur. Why is this? One most likely culprit is COMPLACENCY.

Complacency is hard to identify because it does not result in one specific type of injury.

Complacency has resulted in *442 preventable deaths each day.

Preventable injuries are at an all-time high, ranking as the leading cause of death behind heart disease and cancer.

In 2018, there was a ____ increase in fatalities resulting from workers being caught n running equipment or machinery.

*The Fatal Four were responsible for more than half of construction worker fatalities.

Does complacency exist in my organization? Conditions that lead to complacency

- Experienced workers that have been performing the same task for many years.
- Workers that perform routine and/or repetitious tasks daily.
- It has been a long time since your organization had a serious accident/injury to occur.
- Workers rushing to perform tasks.

How to combat complacency in your organization

- Have frequent safety meetings and workplace discussions about complacency.
- Train employees frequently on the hazards involved with their jobs.
- Look for at-risk behaviors in your facility.
- Empower your employees to look for complacency in others and bring attention to unsafe actions and/or conditions.
